Primary Purpose of the Job:

To perform a variety of tests within the Medical Laboratory covering all the laboratory sections using manual or computerised techniques in order to provide Medical Officers with relevant laboratory results, which will be used in diagnosis, treatment and follow up of different ages. To obtain blood samples from patients of different ages.

Principal Accountabilities & Responsibilities:

- 1. To obtain blood samples and other biological samples from patients of all ages from very young to elderly, using standard venipuncture techniques and ensuring that all appropriate safety standards and procedure are followed.
- 2. To perform a variety of laboratory tests, either manually or using a sophisticated computerised system, review test results against normal values and determine any further tests or analysis required in the event of abnormality and advise by the Medical Officer of results via computerised Medical Records System and Medical Information Management System.
- 3. To prepare laboratory reagents and identify samples for analysis using various analysers, check tests results and review trends for any abnormalities under the supervision of Laboratory Technologist or Chief, enter results into the computerised medical records systems and MIMS or prepare hard copy.
- 4. To analyze samples for chemical content or a chemical reaction and determine concentrations of compounds such as blood glucose and cholesterol levels.
- 5. To perform hormonal and immunological assays using fully automated machines.
- 6. To perform specialised microbiological procedures to isolate and identify the causative organisms of various infections and their antibiotic sensitivity patterns, review results normal values and investigate deviations. Keep up to date wit the new development in microbiology and in the methods of isolation and identification of the organisms.
- 7. To carryout preventive maintenance for the laboratory analysers to maintain them in an effective working order, check equipment and calibrate them to ensure accuracy and precision and advise supervisor of any faults.
- 8. To analyse different fluids, e.g. urine analysis, semen analysis, etc.
- 9. To maintain all aspects of health and safety in the laboratory by ensuring that all safety procedures are followed in work methods and in the disposal of used or infected items such syringes, culture media and laboratory samples.
- 10. To liaise with external send away samples from external accredited laboratories with service level agreement.
- 11. To advise chief laboratory technologist of low stock situation of any consumable item in the laboratory.
- 12. To prepare and perform periodical stand by duties responding to all calls for after working hours and weekends holidays received through nursing staff/medical officer.
- 13. To use the Medical Information Management System to match the patient with the correct pathology request and laboratory results.
- 14. Attend continuing medical education and in-service training.

Decision Making Authority:

❖ Performs laboratory tests procedure with supervision of Chief Tech, and the taking of blood samples without supervision.
